

I am an elected workers' representative. As a cleaner on the underground, I know what it means to get off your knees and fight for your rights. 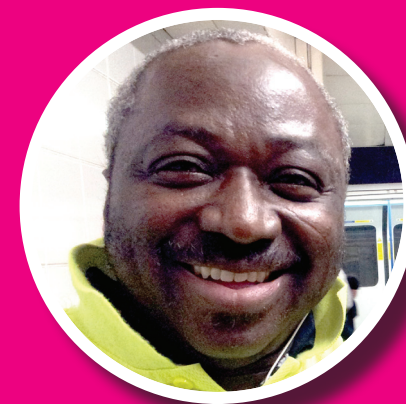

No to cuts! Our Labour council plans £54 million cuts over three years on top of £90m cut already made. Now refuse workers faced an outrageous £1000 cut in pay!

TUSC says No Cuts and demands a £10 an hour minimum wage and an end to zero-hour contracts. TUSC stands for the defence of union rights and a 35-hour week without loss of pay.

Health: Queen's A&E struggles, King George's A&E faces closure. TUSC stands for an NHS free at the point of use for all.

Private landlords are moving in, charging sky-high rents. The risk of repossession in Barking is the highest in England. Barking's eviction risk is the second highest in London.

- For immediate introduction of rent controls. For a massive building programme of affordable, high quality, environmentally friendly council homes
